



# SEASONAL OCEAN LIFEGUARD JUNIOR LIFEGUARD INSTRUCTOR

*Contract, part-time position; no benefits.*

**HOURLY RATE: \$14.74 - \$20.94**

**THE POSITION:** Safeguards the public using the beach and ocean waters; detects and rescues persons or vessels in distress; enforces beach regulations; provides assistance to beach users; teaches ocean rescue techniques, beach first aid, lifeguard communications and use of rescue boards/equipment to children in the Junior Lifeguard Program; performs related duties and responsibilities as assigned.

**EXAMPLES OF IMPORTANT & ESSENTIAL DUTIES:** *Duties include but are not limited to:* Patrol and perform preventative actions, rescues, and safety interventions; render aid and medical assistance; issue water safety warnings; operate and maintain rescue equipment; advise the public of laws, rules, regulations, and safety practices governing beach use; respond to call outs for beach and other emergencies and perform related duties and responsibilities.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:** Essential duties require the strenuous physical activities and skills associated with open water lifeguarding. The work environment includes possible exposure to cold, heat, chemical, biological, environmental and mechanical hazards. Candidates must have the ability to travel to different sites and locations.

## REQUIRED TO APPLY

The following required **certifications\*** must be attached to a completed City of Encinitas application and submitted to Human Resources prior to testing:

- Certificate of completion of an Open Water Lifeguarding Course approved by the USLA
- A valid CPR Certificate for Rescuer or Healthcare Provider
- Emergency Response Certification **OR** Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Certificate

**\*Applications without certification copies will be considered incomplete. However, proof of current enrollment in not more than 2 of the 3 required certificates listed above will be accepted with application. Applicant must complete courses and receive certifications before starting contract employment with the City. ## REQUIRED TO PHYSICALLY TEST

Applicants must be **18 years of age or older**, present a **valid California Driver's License**, and have submitted an application with copies of required **certifications\*** to be eligible to physically test.

Testing will be held at **Moonlight Beach**, Encinitas:

- **9:00 am, Wednesday, April 6, 2011**
- **9:00 am, Wednesday, May 4, 2011**
- **9:00 am, Wednesday, June 8, 2011**

The **physical testing** will consist of:

- 500 meter ocean swim in less than 10 minutes
- Dummy Drag of 50 feet in 30 seconds
- CPR drill
- Paddleboard test

**Interviews** by a panel will occur on the day of testing, beginning at 1:00 pm for Individuals who passed all portions of the physical and skills tests listed above.



## REQUIRED UPON HIRE

1. A valid California driver's license
2. Certificate of completion of an Open Water Lifeguarding Course approved by the USLA
3. A valid CPR Certificate for Rescuer or Healthcare Provider
4. Emergency Response Certification **OR** Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Certificate

**PLEASE NOTE:** Qualified applicants who move to the next level of the selection process must notify the HR Office if accommodation is needed. This recruitment will create an eligibility list that may be used to fill vacancies within the classification for the next 6 months. The post contingent job offer pre-placement process consists of fingerprinting, background check, and a physical examination, which includes a drug and alcohol screening.
