Local and National Information

EMT:

Beginning in 2010, all new EMT applicants must be "Live Scanned" and processed through the FBI.

The DOT is still in the process of restructuring the EMS System. EMT Basic will remain basically the same with a slight increase in hours and EMT Advanced will be implemented mainly for the purpose of EMT transport personnel.

Orange County has recently changed its EMT standards in an attempt to correspond with LA and San Diego. An additional 4 hours of training is required and will include paramedic assistance with the administration of glucose, epi pens, nitro, glucometer, auto injectors and the use of an auto pulse machine and the application of a 12 lead. Combi tubes are no longer permitted.
